Nor Cal ASA, will host the 2007 ASA Girls' "A" 16u Fast-Pitch Championships in Sunnyvale, California, Wednesday, August 1 to August 5, 2007. We are very excited to have this tournament in Northern California.



The Softball Facility at the Global Sports-Twin Creeks Sports Complex has ten (10) lighted fields.

Traveling to Sunnyvale, Ca you can fly directly to the Norman Minetta International Airport in San Jose (10 min. from park), the San Francisco International Airport (35 min. from park) or Oakland International Airport (40 min. from park) on most major airlines.
